We have some items on the calendar, here's what you need to know!

Coming up first is **ADOPT-A-HIGHWAY** - here's much of what we cleaned up in the last run of last year.



The first date for this year is on Saturday, May 8th. That's a week away, and before the next club meeting, so this may be the last advance notice you will see. It was announced at the last club meeting and on the website since. We will leave promptly at 9:00 am from Whiskey Corners. Everything is provided, safety vest, trash bags, tools. It's a nice walk down

the highway with your fellow SnoBirds. Afterwards, we will meet at Whiskey Corners for refreshments, food, and fellowship. It's SPRING, come out and get some fresh air!

The next item to mention is our second **Gun Raffle**. With the loss of the Smelt Fry last year, the Gun Raffle, along with WCSA's raffle, stepped in to provide us with some funding. It's not as much as the Smelt Fry took in past years, but went well consid-

ering Covid, and was a lot less "iffy" in terms of attendance and ticket sales and actual work on the day of the event. We will again have four prizes this year; first prize will be the winner's choice of a Beretta A300 Outlander Synthetic Semi-Auto-



matic 12-gauge Shotgun, or \$400 cash. The Beretta is a quality, name-brand gun, and is in very scarce supply with the current shortages. MSRP is \$800, IF you can find one. Places selling it at a discount are out of stock, and other locations demand a premium over MSRP. This should be a major selling point for the tickets. Second through Fourth prizes are not firmed up yet, we have some items now but are looking for additional donations.

This will all be decided and tickets will be printed and available at the June club meeting. The raffle drawing is planned for September 14th, so we will have three months to sell tickets.
